



NOTICE OF PRIVACY PRACTICES

This Notice of Privacy Practices (“Notice”) describes how InfuCare Rx, Inc. and its affiliates and subsidiaries (collectively, “InfuCare Rx” or the “Company”) may use or disclose your health information and how you can get access to this information. Information disclosed pursuant to this Notice may be subject to redisclosure and may no longer be protected by this Notice. **Please review it carefully.**

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Get a copy of your paper or electronic medical record
- Correct your paper or electronic medical record
- Request confidential communication
- Ask us to limit the information we share
- Get a list of those with whom we’ve shared your information
- Get a copy of this privacy Notice
- Choose someone to act for you
- File a complaint if you believe your privacy rights have been violated

Your Choices

For certain health information, you can tell us your choices about what we share. If you have a clear preference for how we share your information in the situations described below, talk to us. Tell us what you want us to do, and we will follow your instructions.

In these cases, you have both the right and choice to tell us to:

- Share information with your family, close friends, or others involved in your care
- Share information in a disaster relief situation

If you are not able to tell us your preference, for example if you are unconscious, we may go ahead and share your information if we believe it is in your best interest. We may also share your information when needed to lessen a serious and imminent threat to health or safety.

In these cases, we never share your health information unless you give us written authorization:

- Marketing purposes
- Sale of your information
- Most sharing of psychotherapy notes
- Sharing of reproductive health information
- Sharing of substance abuse treatment records. These records will not be disclosed without your written authorization, except in limited situations, such as medical emergencies, reporting to appropriate oversight agencies, or as otherwise required by law.

In the case of fundraising:

- We may contact you for fundraising efforts, but you can tell us not to contact you again. You may opt out by contacting our Compliance Department at corporatecompliance@infucarerx.com.



Our Uses and Disclosures

We may use and share your information as we:

- Treat you
- Run our organization
- Bill for your services
- Help with public health and safety issues such as:
 - Preventing disease
 - Helping with product recalls
 - Reporting adverse reactions to medications
 - Reporting suspected abuse, neglect, or domestic violence
 - Preventing or reducing a serious threat to anyone's health or safety
- Do research
- Comply with the law
- Respond to organ and tissue donation requests
- Work with a medical examiner or funeral director
- Address workers' compensation, law enforcement, and other government requests
- Respond to lawsuits and legal actions

Reproductive Health Information

We cannot use or share information about your involvement in reproductive health care for situations such as imposing an investigation, imposing a liability, or to identify any person to initiate such activities. This restriction applies only when we determine one of the following conditions exists:

- Reproductive health care is lawful under the state law in which it is provided and the circumstances in which it is provided. For example, if a resident of one state travels to another state to receive reproductive health care, such as an abortion, that is lawful in the state where the care is rendered.
- Reproductive health care is protected, required, or allowed by Federal law, including the U.S. Constitution.
- Reproductive health care is provided by someone else and presumed lawful. We presume reproductive health care lawful unless we have any of the following:
 - Knowledge that reproductive health care is not lawful under the circumstances in which it is provided.
 - Information from the requester demonstrating reproductive health care is not lawful under the circumstances in which it is provided.

We can share information potentially related to reproductive health care if we receive a valid attestation from the requestor that the information is not for health oversight activities, judicial and administrative proceedings, law enforcement purposes, or disclosure to coroners or medical officers. For example, if law enforcement requests protected health information potentially related to reproductive health care for information about a crime victim, we require a valid attestation. We cannot use or share information about your involvement in reproductive health care if we receive a defective attestation. We are responsible for ensuring that the required elements of the attestation are met.

Special Note Regarding Individual State Law

In cases where individual State law is more restrictive than Federal law, we are required to follow the more restrictive State law. Under more restrictive State laws, your authorization may be required for the use or disclosure of Personal Information that includes information relating to any of the following:

- Infection with or exposure to HIV, or the results of HIV tests, except if you are an injured worker claiming to be infected with or exposed to HIV due to a work-related incident
- Mental health
- Diagnosis or treatment for substance abuse

Our Responsibilities

- We are required by law to maintain the privacy and security of your protected health information.
- We will let you know promptly if a breach occurs that may have compromised the privacy or security of



your information.

- We must follow the duties and privacy practices described in this notice and give you a copy of it.
- We will not use or share your information other than as described here unless you tell us we can in writing. If you tell us we can, you may change your mind at any time. Let us know in writing if you change your mind.
